Detailed Election Process for Student Council 2025-2026

Step 1: Nomination

- The completed form, along with required signatures, must be submitted by Deadline Date to the class teacher.

Step 2: Campaigning

- The official campaign period will start on Campaign Start Date as mentioned and end on Campaign End Date as mentioned.
- During this period, candidates can prepare campaign materials, such as posters and speeches. All campaign activities must adhere to the school's guidelines.

- Each student in Grade 8 will cast a secret ballot for their preferred candidates.
- Ballot papers will be provided, and students will mark their choices confidentially.

Step 4: Results Announcement

- The results will be announced during a special assembly on Announcement Date as mentioned.
- Elected council members will be formally inducted and will assume their roles immediately.

- Assist in enforcing school rules and regulations.


5. House Captains (Grade 6, Boy and Girl for each House):

- Lead their respective houses.
- Organize and coordinate house activities and events.
