Subject : Mandatory Safety Guidelines for Students Commuting by bicycle

Dear Parents,

At Mount Litera Zee School Ghogali, the safety and well-being of our students is our top priority. Many of our children commute to school by bicycle, and while cycling is healthy and eco-friendly, it also requires careful attention to safety. To protect every child and avoid any mishaps, we request your kind cooperation in following these safety guidelines:

1. **Helmet Compulsory** – Every child must wear a proper helmet while cycling.
2. **Traffic Rules** – Students must follow all traffic signals, ride only on the left side, and strictly obey road safety rules.
3. **Cycle Fitness** – Bicycles must be in safe and roadworthy condition with working brakes, tyres, reflectors, and lights.
4. **Parental Responsibility** – Parents are requested to regularly guide, remind, and monitor their wards regarding safe cycling practices. They should also be **aware of with whom their ward is travelling, whether the child is coming directly from school, and the usual time taken to reach home.**
5. **Reporting Time & Traffic Rush** – Students commuting by cycle must reach school before 8:40 a.m. As there is heavy movement of school buses and private vehicles during arrival and dispersal, parents must ensure their ward cycles carefully and reaches school/home safely and on time. In unavoidable circumstances, students may arrive by 9:30 a.m., but should not rush or ride recklessly. **It is expected that consideration which is being given by principal (only for safety reasons) will not be misused.**

We seek your wholehearted support in this matter, as student safety is a shared responsibility between school and parents. Together, we can ensure that our children enjoy cycling while staying safe.

Note: Parents are requested to inform the **class teacher** if their ward commutes to school by bicycle.
