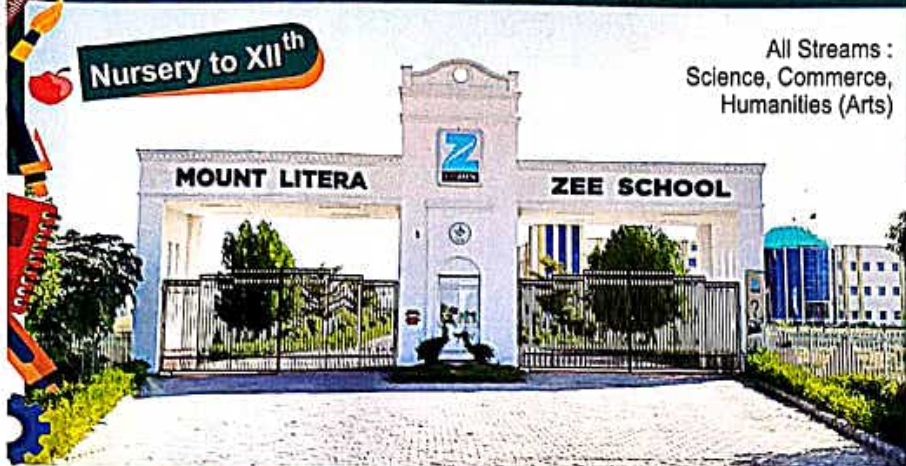

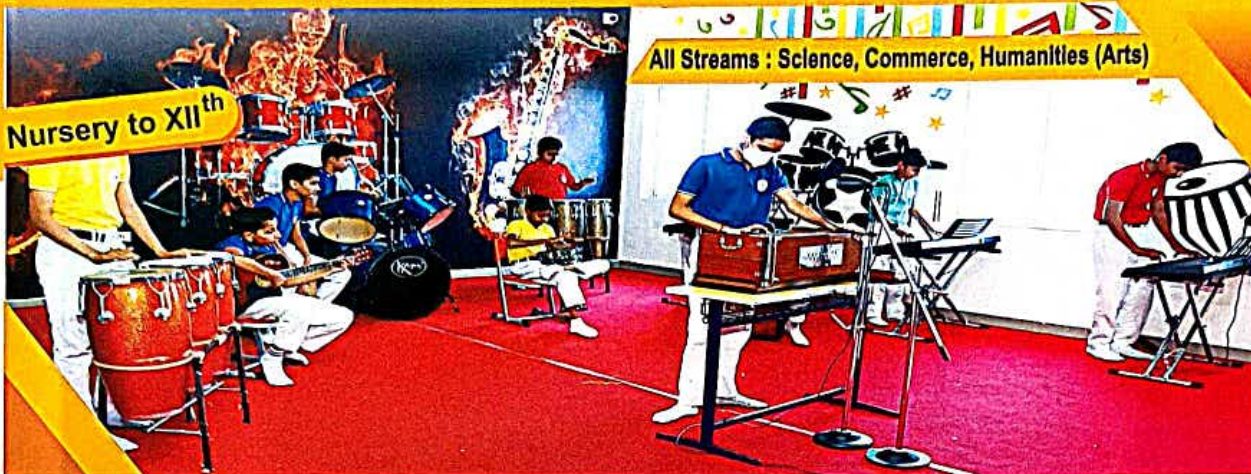

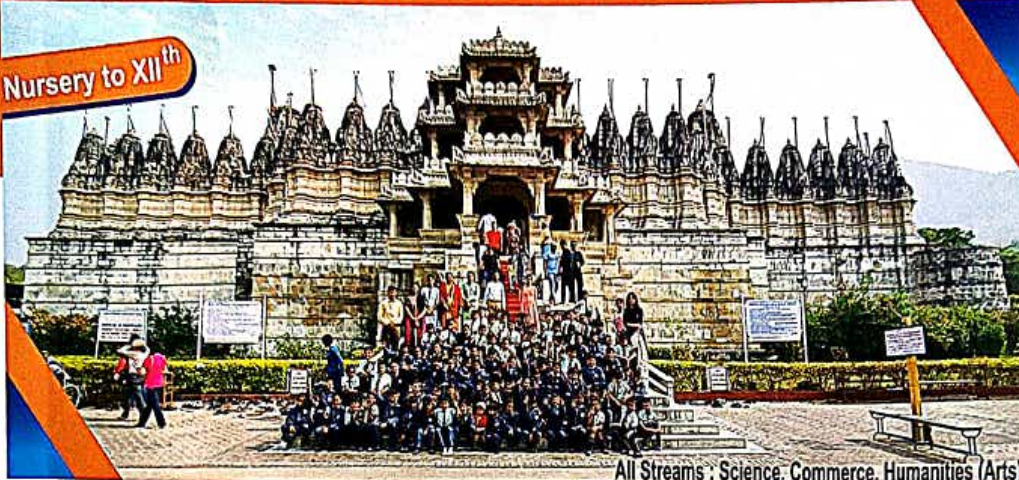

- Pledge Ceremony – Have students take a pledge to maintain cleanliness in their school and community.

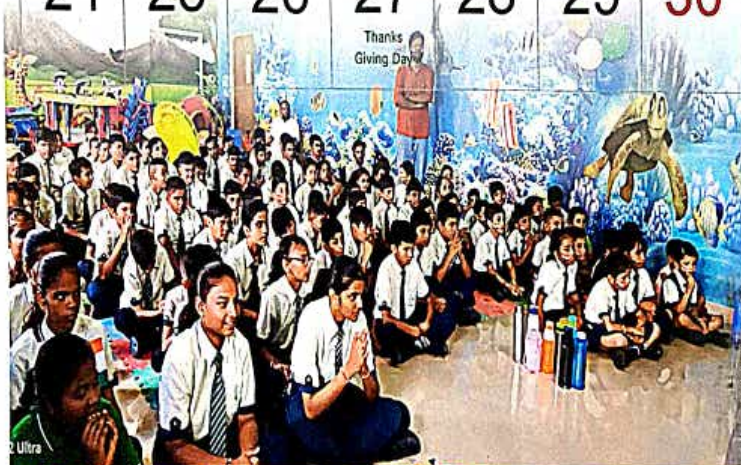
